Dear Humboldt County Voters:

The 2024 Primary Election will be conducted by mail and in-person voting. Every active registered voter in Humboldt County will receive a vote-by-mail ballot unless the voter has chosen to opt-out using the Mail Ballot Preference Form.

Please note, that if you received a vote-by-mail ballot and wish to vote in person you may do so. Either bring your unused ballot to surrender to a Humboldt County Election Worker or be prepared to sign an affidavit stating you will not attempt to vote your unused vote-by-mail ballot.

The Clerk's office has included in this *Voter Information and Sample Ballot*. A list of the candidates and contests by party who are on the Primary ballot, as well as several ***Frequently Asked Questions*** that we hope will be useful. Please take a moment to review and become familiar with what you may expect for this Primary Election.

We encourage you to confirm your voter registration is current by going online to **[www.RegisterToVoteNV.gov](http://www.RegisterToVoteNV.gov)** or by contacting the Clerk's office directly. Please also note within the FAQs that Nevada is a closed Primary state. If you are not affiliated with a major political party, you will be mailed a nonpartisan ballot.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHY DID I RECEIVE A MAIL BALLOT?

During the 2021 Legislative Session Assembly Bill No. 321 was passed. This bill designated all active registered voters in Nevada to receive a vote-by-mail ballot for every election. This means you will receive a mail ballot automatically to the mailing address on your voter registration before each election, unless you have completed a Mail Ballot Preference Form and chose to opt-out by the April 12, 2024 deadline for the Primary Election. Those Mail Ballot Preference Forms received after the deadline will be entered for all future elections.

### HOW DO I VOTE MY MAIL BALLOT?

You will receive your official ballot the second or third week of May. **DO NOT THROW YOUR BALLOT AWAY!** To vote your ballot:

1. Mark your ballot (**instructions will be provided with your ballot**);
  2. **Sign** the return envelope (for verification purposes); and
  3. Return your ballot in the postage-paid envelope by mail or deliver it in-person to the County Clerk's office or Polling Place during Early Voting and Election Day.
- **Your voted ballot must be postmarked by June 11, 2024, and received by the Clerk's office by 5:00 p.m. on the fourth day after the election, June 15, 2024.**
  - **If you are delivering your voted ballot in-person, the ballot must be received by the Clerk's office no later than 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 11, 2024.**

If you do not receive a ballot by **May 28, 2024**, or you need a replacement ballot, please contact the Clerk's office at (775) 623-6343 or via email at [elections@humboldtcountynv.gov](mailto:elections@humboldtcountynv.gov).

### REMEMBER:

**Ballot Return Envelope must be SIGNED by the REGISTERED VOTER or the required statement completed.**

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS CONTINUED

### HOW DO I VOTE IN PERSON?

If you completed a Mail Ballot Preference Form and chose to opt-out of receiving a vote by mail ballot, you will vote in person at your designated polling location.

- All precincts may vote in person during early voting at the Humboldt County Courthouse, in the Humboldt County Meeting Room, located at 50 W. 5th Street, Room 201, Winnemucca, Nevada 89445.
- All precincts may vote at the Winnemucca Convention Center, West Hall, on Election Day, located at 50 W. Winnemucca Boulevard, Winnemucca, Nevada 89445.
- All Precincts may vote in person at the Fort McDermitt Tribal Administration Building, located at 111 North Road, McDermitt, Nevada 89421 on Election Day and during scheduled Early Voting hours.
- All Precincts may vote in person at the Orovada Community Hall, located on Rock Creek Road, Orovada, Nevada 89425, on Election Day only.
- All precincts may vote in person at the Paradise Valley Sports Center, located at 110 W. Bridge Street, Paradise Valley, Nevada 89426, on Election Day only.

**Even if you received a vote-by-mail ballot, you may still vote in person.** You will either need to surrender your unused paper ballot to a Humboldt County Election Worker when you appear to vote or be prepared to sign an affidavit stating you will not attempt to vote your unused vote-by-mail ballot.

**REVIEWING YOUR BALLOT:** Each voting machine will allow you to review your ballot before printing. After you have reviewed your ballot on the screen, print a paper record of your selections. You can review your selections to ensure you have not made a mistake before casting your ballot. If you note a mistake, you can “make changes” and it will return you to the ballot screen. Another record of your selections will print out to review before casting your ballot. Once you cast your ballot the paper printout will scroll out of view and the machine will be ready for the next voter. Return your VOTER CARD to a Humboldt County Election Worker or to the place designated in your polling location.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS CONTINUED

### HOW DO I VOTE IN PERSON? CONTINUED:

BRING YOUR SAMPLE BALLOT WHEN YOU GO TO THE POLLS TO  
VOTE!

Voters are encouraged to confirm that their voter registration information is up-to-date, including mailing address and political party affiliation, now and not rely on the same-day registration process. Visit [www.RegisterToVote.NV.gov](http://www.RegisterToVote.NV.gov) to register to vote online or make updates to your existing voter record.

#### PLEASE REMEMBER:

NRS 293.740 prohibits soliciting votes and electioneering inside a polling place or within one hundred (100) feet of a polling place. "Electioneering" means campaigning for or against a candidate, ballot question, or political party by:

- Posting signs relating to the support of or opposition to a candidate, ballot question, or political party;
- Distributing literature relating to the support of or opposition to a candidate, ballot question, or political party;
- Buying, selling, wearing or displaying any badge, button or other insignia which is designed or tends to aid or promote the success or defeat of any political party or a candidate or ballot question to be voted upon at the election; or
- Soliciting signatures to any kind of petition.

**WARNING: A person who is entitled to vote shall not vote or attempt to vote more than once in the same election. Any person who votes or attempts to vote twice at the same election is guilty of a Category D Felony and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130. (NRS 293.780)**

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS CONTINUED

### WHO WILL BE ON MY BALLOT?

This *Voter Information and Sample Ballot* lists **ALL** candidates and contests that are on the Primary ballot. You will receive a ballot that contains the candidates for your major party affiliation and nonpartisan candidates. If you are affiliated as nonpartisan, or with a minor party, your ballot will contain only nonpartisan candidates. You may verify your current party affiliation, or no affiliation (nonpartisan) by looking at the mailing label of this Sample Ballot.

### HOW DO I CHANGE MY PARTY AFFILIATION OR UPDATE MY REGISTRATION?

The preferred method to update your party affiliation **for this election** is to use the Nevada Secretary of State's online link [www.RegisterToVote.NV.gov](http://www.RegisterToVote.NV.gov). Otherwise, please contact the Clerk's office for more information. If your party change is processed on or before May 28, 2024, a replacement ballot will be mailed to you. Party changes after May 28, 2024, must be made online at [www.RegisterToVote.NV.gov](http://www.RegisterToVote.NV.gov) or in person during Early Voting or on Election Day and you will have to vote in person.

### WHAT IMPORTANT DEADLINES ARE APPROACHING?

**May 14, 2024 (voter registrations must be postmarked or received by the Clerk's office by this date)**

Standard close of voter registration (in-person, agency (including DMV), and mail).

**May 15 - May 28, 2024**

**Online only** voter registration and voter registration updates. Mailed or over-the-counter voter registrations are not accepted during this time.

**May 29 – June 11, 2024:**

**Anyone registering to vote online or updating their voter registration online** during this time **MUST** appear in-person during Early Voting or Election Day and bring a valid Nevada Driver's License, Nevada Identification Card, or Nevada Tribal Identification Card and proof of residency if applicable.

### WHAT IF I MISSED THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE?

A resident of Nevada may same-day register in-person at their polling location during Early Voting or Election Day.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS CONTINUED

### **WHO QUALIFIES TO SAME-DAY REGISTER?**

A citizen of the United States who will be 18 by Election Day, who has continuously resided in this State and in this county for 30 days and in the precinct 10 days before Election Day.

### **HOW DO I SAME-DAY REGISTER?**

You will need to appear in-person at the polling location during Early Voting or on Election Day. You must provide a valid Nevada Driver's License, Nevada Identification Card, or Nevada Tribal ID card and proof of current residency, if applicable.

### **WILL MY VOTE BE COUNTED ON ELECTION DAY IF I SAME-DAY REGISTER?**

Qualified same day registrants will vote an electronic provisional ballot containing all the candidates and contests as a regular ballot. Provisional ballots **will not** be counted until it is determined that the voter has not cast a ballot in any other Nevada county for this election.

### **WHY IS MY IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED?**

If you registered to vote by mail or did not provide ID at the time of registering, or a signature match to your voter registration cannot be made, proof of identity and residence may be required to cast a ballot.

### **WHAT IF MY ENVELOPE STATES "ID REQUIRED"?**

If you registered to vote by mail, or did not provide proof of identity at the time of registering, you may be required to provide proof of identity and residence with your ballot. If you have any questions contact the Clerk's office.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS CONTINUED

### **ASSISTANCE WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR VOTERS IF NEEDED.**

Ask an election worker for assistance:

- If you need help reading the ballot or operating the voting machine.
- If you think you have received an incorrect ballot style. Do not cast the ballot.

Every polling place has a voting machine that can enlarge the screen on the voting machine, print the voter-verifiable paper trail in extra large font, support audio voting and support “sip and puff” technology.

Reasonable accommodations will be made to help any voter requesting assistance at a polling place. (NRS 293.565(12))

### **HOW DO I VOTE IF I AM UNABLE TO SIGN MY BALLOT DUE TO A LIMITING CONDITION?**

The Nevada Secretary of State’s Office has a web-based solution if you are unable to sign your ballot. Please visit [NVEASE.gov](http://NVEASE.gov) to find out more. Reasonable accommodations will be made to help any voter request assistance at a polling location. (NRS 293.565(12)). You may also have someone assist you in signing your ballot, if you have a physical disability, are at least 65 years of age or you are unable to read or write, contact the Clerk’s Office for more information.
