Mining Claim Filing Requirements in Nevada (as of 1/2/2025)

An annual filing must be made for each lode or placer claim and each mill or tunnel site with:

1	When to File for:	County Recorder	US Bureau of Land Management (BLM)
	New Claims	Within 90 days after the date of location	Within 90 days after the date of location
	Renewal - Claim Maintenance Fees	File on or before November 1 of each year	File on or before September 1 of each year
	Small Miner Exemption	n/a	File on or before September 1 of each year
	Renewal - Annual Assessment Work (Proof of Labor)	File on or before November 1 of each year	File on or before December 30 of calendar year in which the assessment year ends.
